This Mid Western University has nearly 60,000 students. And it offers over 12,000 courses in some 174 undergraduate major programs. In terms of real estate, its campuses encompass over 15,000 acres.

It has three major components: The University, Health System and Research Foundation. While all three of these institutions share a common heritage – and especially a common name – what they did not share (until now) was a common financial system. The University, the Health System and the Research Foundation each operated independent financial processes and systems. This fragmentation has limited the interface between the related, but partially connected organizations, resulting in serious issues regarding financial tracking, reconciliation, and reporting.

To address these concerns, The University, through its Office of Information Technology, has undertaken a large-scale PeopleSoft implementation and Upgrade projects with help from Digitek Software, Inc. The selection of Digitek as a partner firm was only done after an exhaustive RFP process that evaluated some 45 different vendor companies.
